MEDICATIONS TO BE WITHHELD BEFORE ALLERGY TESTING.

If you are taking *any* BETA BLOCKERS or GLAUCOMA eye drops (see attached list)

You MUST let us know *as soon as possible*, DO NOT STOP TAKING ANY
 BETABLOCKERS WITHOUT YOUR DOCTORS CONSENT.

Continue to take all of your asthma medication.

Non-sedating antihistamine: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Astemizole (Hismanal) • Loratadine (Claritin) • Fexofenadine (allegra) • Cetirizine (Zyrtec) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hismanal: 14 days before testing • Claritin: 7 days before testing • Allergra: 7 days before testing • Zyrtec: 7 days before testing
