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## WHEN TO RESCHEDULE YOUR ALLERGY TEST

If you have any questions about whether you should come in for your allergy injection, please call us at 715-828-2368. If we do not answer, please leave us a message and we will return your call promptly between patients.

You should call to reschedule your injection if:

- You are running a fever
- You are receiving another injection on the same day
- You are wheezing (asthmatics)
- You feel overly fatigued or exhausted
- You are having acute, severe allergy symptoms
- You have a new cough, cold or are not feeling well

If you have any of the above symptoms or cannot come to your scheduled appointment, please call and let us know. The courtesy of advanced notice can help us offer another patient services during your rescheduled time.

Please keep in mind, it is best to avoid strenuous exercise for one hour prior to and following your injection.

Remember to report any redness and/or swelling that you might have noticed at the injection site that lasts longer than 24 hours.
